PREFATORY REMARKS

This bibliography lists the catalogues of contemporary and former private and public collections in all states of the former Soviet Union with holdings in Dutch and Flemish art. It was compiled by the Foundation for Cultural Inventory (SCI) in Amsterdam for the CODART TWEE congress and study trip in 1999. For this publication (2005) it has been extended and updated.

Titles in Cyrillic are transcribed into the Latin alphabet according to the most common system used in English.

English titles between angular brackets are translations of the original titles by the compilers of this list. This means that, unless specifically mentioned otherwise, there is no text other than Russian (or Ukrainian) in the book. Only the names of painters are often given in their original, Latin spelling as well.

For more recent publications of the Hermitage and the Pushkin Museum the list is restricted to the more substantial catalogues. Smaller and more popular publications are only cited when they focus on Netherlandish items. For all other museums the number of publications is so restricted that even the smallest guidebooks are incorporated.

A number of exhibition catalogues with important information on collections is added to the general section or arranged by location of the (most important) collection involved.

Each title in the location section is preceded by the name of the collection. This is the present name of the collection if the collection still exists. Collections that are merged with others are under their former name.
